1. Prescribing Antibiotics

Update participants in a variety of infections and their treatments

2. A Complex Co-Morbid Conundrum: Pain Management for Patients Presenting with a Substance Use Disorder

Provide participants with a range of knowledge which will enable them to not only understand the complex relationship between pain and substance use disorders but also understand how to manage patients in an appropriate manner who present to them.

3. From Baby Grows to Growing Babies: Non Medical Prescribing Update Training in Paediatrics

Update prescribers on the safety and efficacy issues facing the Non Medical Prescriber caring for neonates, babies and children and how to ensure appropriate prescribing.

4. To PGD or not to PGD – that is the question Patient Group Direction (PGD) Update and Training

Update participants in a variety of medicines management issues to improve safety and efficacy of medicines for patients whilst building on participants' personal experience and knowledge.

8. Non Medical Prescribing Update for Nurse/Pharmacist/AHP Independent & Supplementary Prescribers (V300/200)

Assist participants to ensure they are up to date with the latest developments in NMP, thus enabling them to use their prescribing skills to maximise patient care.

9. “Back to Basics” Prescribing Update for Community Practitioner Formulary Nurse Prescribers (V100/150)

Assist participants to ensure they are using their prescribing skills to maximise patient care.

10. Prescribing Topical Treatments for Skin Problems

To increase participants knowledge of management of skin diseases and explore various topical management options including prescribing.

11. Evidence Based Prescribing

Enable participants to understand and take into account the evidence available in order to make safer prescribing decisions when prescribing for patients

12. Prescribing for Diabetics

To update participants in safe effective prescribing for diabetes.

13. Prescribing in Palliative Care

To update and challenge participants in the practice of prescribing in general and specialist palliative care.
