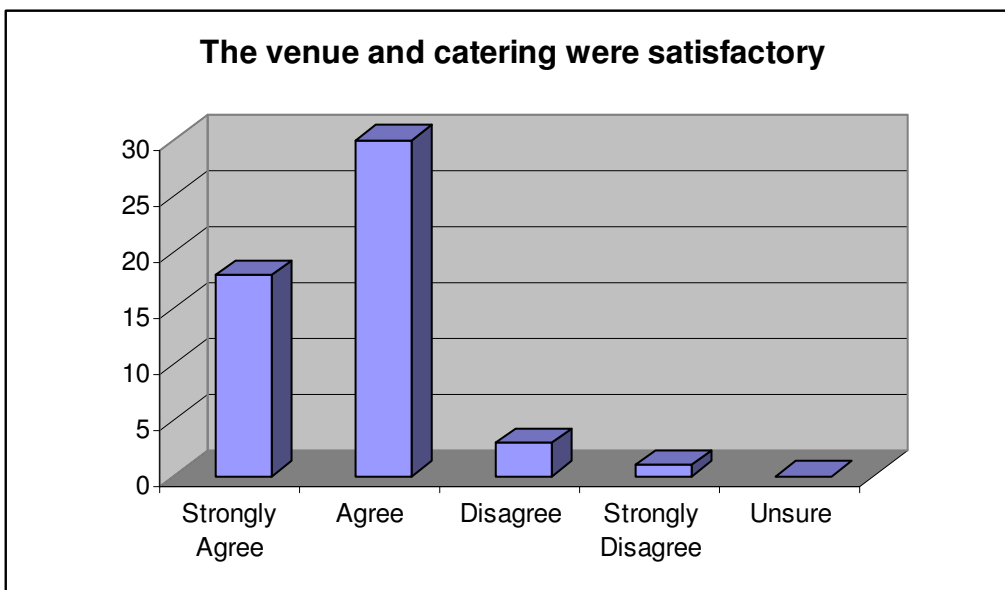
96 % of delegates felt the event was relevant to their work



80% of delegates felt the content was presented at an appropriate level for them

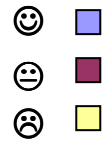
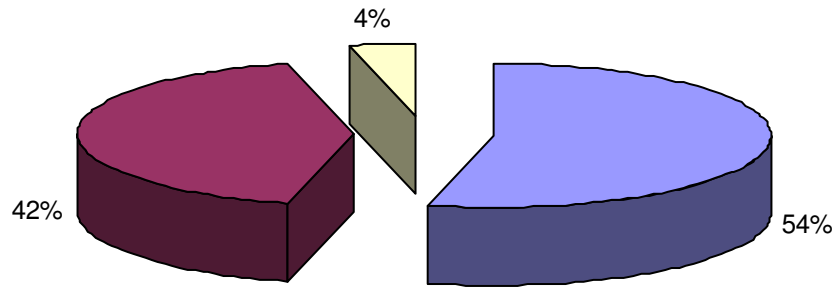
