

The target audience for this event is qualified Non Medical Prescribers working in Secondary Care; Clinical Specialist Nurses, Midwives, Pharmacists, Physiotherapists, Radiographers and Podiatrists. The NMC are currently working on guidance for CPD for prescribers. This will be in addition to Practice Standard 15 in their *Standards of proficiency for nurse and midwife prescribers*. The DH document *A Guide to Implementing Nurse and Pharmacist Independent Prescribing within the NHS in England*, also addresses the importance of CPD in relation to your prescribing role. The Royal Pharmaceutical Society of Great Britain's document, *Professional Standards and Guidance for Pharmacist Prescribers* suggests that “as a pharmacist who is recorded on the register as being a prescriber, you must ensure that part of your CPD directly addresses your role as a prescriber. This includes keeping up to date with relevant changes in the law as well as the therapeutic areas in which you prescribe”. This event will assist in addressing CPD for Non Medical Prescribers.
